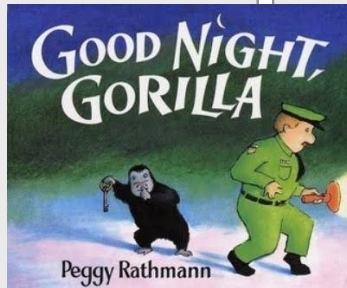


## Communication & Language

## Reading:

Listening to stories and rhymes and joining in  
Talking about who is in a story, where it happens and what happens  
Retelling stories I know well and making up my own



Reading some simple words: a, the, in, on, and, I

Using phonics to read simple words like pin, cat

Begin to read simple sentences and simple books matched to their phonics

Story books: Penguin Small, Lost and Found, Good Night Gorilla

Sharing information books about animals, Autumn and hot and cold places

## Writing:

Mark making and saying what it means  
Writing my name and some simple words  
Using some letters in my writing  
Writing for different purposes: labels and signs, invitations, lists, letters, cards

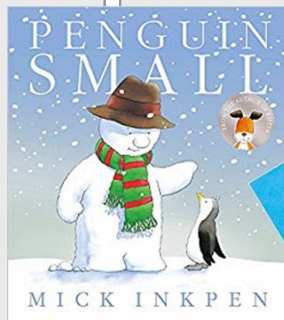

Riding trikes and tractors

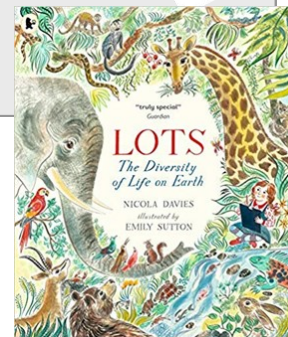
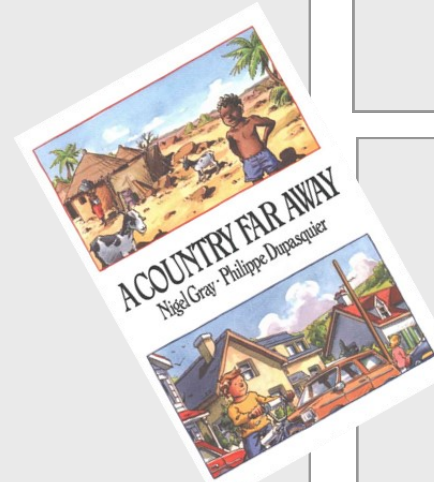
Moving in different ways and using different body parts

## Maths-shape, space & measures

Making pictures, patterns and models with shapes and talking about them  
Comparing heavier and lighter  
Using language of time: now, next, morning, afternoon, day, night etc.  
Using money



## Maths-number

Number rhymes  
Counting objects and making sets to 10  
Reading and ordering numbers to 10  
1 more and 1 less than a number to 10  
Solving problems with numbers

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Trying out new activities  
Choosing and using resources independently  
Taking turns and sharing  
Thinking about how others feel  
*Diamond Power:* spotting and solving problems  
*Ruby Power:* caring and supporting for others

## Understanding the world

Using learnpads and ipads and exploring Purple Mash  
Making digital images  
Why do we celebrate Bonfire Night?  
What is happening in the natural world in Autumn?  
What is it like living in other parts of the world?

How do we celebrate Christmas?  
How did my parents and grandparents celebrate Christmas when they were little?
